LET'S REVISE

Topic 1- Vowels and Consonants

There are 26 alphabets among which
5 are vowels – a,e,i,o,u and rest- 21 are consonants.

Topic 2- Articles ‘a’ or ‘an’

They both are used with singular or one thing but
‘a’ is used with words starting with consonant
sound and ‘an’ is used with the words starting
with vowel sound.

Example- a boy
an orange



TOPIC 3-CAPITAL LETTERS

Capital letters mean capitalization of letters for which you should keep 5 rules in your mind:

- The letter ‘I’ (letter I is always written in capital).
- Beginning letter of every sentence is written in capital.
- Name of person and places always start with capital letter.
- Months and days of the week always start with capital letter.
- Holidays, name of books, festivals always start with capital letter.

RHYMING WORDS

Rhyming words are those words that have the same or similar ending sound.
