
Addition is used to put things together. We use '+' sign for addition.



ADDITION OF 3-DIGIT NUMBERS (WITH REGROUPING)

In addition of 3-digit numbers, we add ones, then tens and then hundreds.

We combine 10 ones to make one ten if there are more than 9 ones.

In the same way, we combine 10 tens to make 1 hundred if the number of tens is more than nine.


