To start the Paint program, follow the steps given below:


Click on the start button

MS Paint Window


It opens like this. It includes paint button, toolbar, ribbon, drawing area.

The Ribbon contains two parts: tabs and groups.


Let's look at Tools and Shapes group in Home tab of the Ribbon.

There are various shapes given in this group which you can use to draw.




How to draw a picture in Paint? Let's see how to draw a hut

Step 2: Click on triangle shape


from Shapes group.

Now click and drag to draw a triangle as shown.





Step 3: Now, select rectangle shape and drag to draw as shown.

Step 4: Now using square make the other part of the hut.




Step 5: Use line tool and make the top roof of the hut and close it.






Step 6: Use rectangle and square to make doors and windows of the hut.




Step 7: Draw clouds, birds and sun using brush tool/pencil from Tool group.


